## S-68/20/02: To consider introduction of awarding Gold Medal to overall topper in PG programme.

The present mandate is to award silver medal to all the toppers of each specialisation provided he/she gets an overall CPI/CGPA not lower than 9.00. The sanctioned seat capacity of the PG is 488. Considering the strength of the PG students and practice in some other NITs it is proposed to award Gold medal to the overall topper of PG graduating student.

Senate may consider the introduction of awarding Gold Medal to PG overall topper and recommend the same to the BoG for approval.
