An M.Tech. student of CE Deptt. Lipika Moharana bearing Regn No. 2021513 has got an appointment as AEE in Govt. of Odisha. Accordingly, she has requested the CE Deptt. to consider her prayer for conversion from Full Time to Part Time. The DPPC, CE Dept. have recommended her prayer for the same.
