The proposed minimum CPI/CGPA is required to become eligible for the award is 8.5, without any F/W grade & without any disciplinary action taken during the entire study period (B.Tech.).

Every year application will be invited from all the Faculty Members of the Institute. Top 20 Faculty will be shortlisted based on the criteria (a) and final selection will be done combining criteria (b).

The above procedure is approved by the Chairman (Officiating), BoG and accordingly the process of selection has been started. The name of Distinguished Faculty for the year 2018-19 will be placed on the day of the BoG Meeting.
